Whereas Rajdoot Paints Limited, a company, registered under the Companies Act, 1956, (hereinafter referred to as "erstwhile Industry"), having their plant as 316 and 317 Kundaim Industrial Estate, Kundaim-Goa, holding Registration Certificate No. M/7723 under the Goa Sales Tax Act, 1964 (Act 4 of 1964) (hereinafter called 'said Act' and No. P (CST)/5583 under the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956 (Central Act 74 of 1956) (hereinafter called 'Central Act') has been extended the benefit of exemption in terms of second proviso to Government Notification No. 5/4/87-FIN (R&C) (i) dated 20-4-1987, vide Notification No. 5/12/95-FIN (R&C) dated 7-6-1999, published on Official Gazette, Series II No. 16, dated 15-7-1999 (hereinafter called 'said exemption');

And whereas M/s. Berger Paints India Ltd., a Company, registered under the Companies Act, 1956 (hereinafter called as the "said Industry") and holding registration certificate No. M/7723 under the said Act and No. P (CST)/5583 under the Central Act, have applied for extension of benefit of said exemption granted to the erstwhile industry in view of amalgamation effected by Order of Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta;

And whereas the Government, on examining the issue in its totality and on considering afresh the proposal in the light of the advice already tendered by the State Pollution Control Board, Panaji, vide their Report No. 5/484/95/PCB/112 dated 21-4-1998, expressing the opinion that the process carried out by the said erstwhile industry is pollution free, which said erstwhile industry has now been taken over by the said industry is of the opinion that the process carried out by the said industry is pollution free.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the second proviso to the Government Notification No. 5/6/98-Fin (R&C) (IV) dated 17-12-1999 published in the Extraordinary Official Gazette, Series I, No. 38 dated 17-12-1999, the Government of Goa hereby extends the benefit of said exemption to the said industry on the following conditions, namely;

- (i) the period of exemption shall be restricted to 10 years i.e. from the date of the Order No. 5/12/95-FIN (R&C) dated 7-6-1999, extending the benefit of exemption to the erstwhile industry now taken over by the said industry by virtue of amalgamation;
- (ii) the benefit of said exemption shall be subject to timely filing of quarterly returns specified under the Goa Sales Tax Act, 1964, (Act 4 of 1964) and the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956 (Central Act 74 of 1956), and claiming of turnover therein;
- (iii) the sales of goods manufactured by the said industry shall be exempted from tax, so long as the said industry, continues to be under the present ownership and the exemption shall stand terminated forthwith if there be any change in ownership of the said industry;
- (iv) if the measures adopted by the said industry to control pollution are at any time found to be inadequate or if the said industry causes any threat to the environment, the benefit shall stand withdrawn forthwith; and
- (v) the said exemption shall be available only during the effectivity of the period under this Order.

And whereas M/s. Berger Paints India Ltd., a Company, registered under the Companies Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the "said Industry") and holding registration certificate No. M/7723 under the said Act and No. P/(CST)/5583 under the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the

"Central Act"), having taken over the entire undertaking with all rights, assets and liabilities of erstwhile Industry by virtue of the amalgamation effected by Order of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta, have applied for the extension of benefit of the said exemption granted to the said industry.

And whereas the Government, on examining the issue in its totality and on considering afresh the proposal in the light of the advice/order already tendered by the State Pollution Control Board, Panaji, vide their report No. 5/484/95/PCB/112 dated 21-4-1998 expressing the opinion that the process carried out by the said erstwhile industry is pollution free which said erstwhile industry has now been taken over by the said industry, is of the opinion that the process carried out by the said industry is pollution free.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the third proviso to entry 85 of the Second Schedule to the said Act, the Government of Goa hereby extends the benefits of exemption under the said entry 85 to the said industry on the following conditions, namely:-

- (i) the period of exemption shall be restricted to 10 years and shall be reckoned from 7-6-1999, i.e. from the date of the Order No. 5/12/95-FIN (R&C) dated 7-6-1999 extending the benefit of said exemption to the erstwhile industry now taken over by the said industry by virtue of the amalgamation;
- (ii) the benefits of exemption shall be subject to timely filing of quarterly returns specified under the Goa Sales Tax Act, 1964 (Act 4 of 1964), and the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956 (Central Act 74 of 1956), and claiming of the turnover therein;
- (iii) the sales of goods manufactured by the said industry shall be exempted from tax, so long as the said industry continues to be under the present ownership and the said exemption shall stand terminated forthwith if there be any change in ownership of the said industry;
- (iv) if the measures adopted by the said industry to control pollution are at any time found to be inadequate or if the said industry causes any threat to the environment, the said exemption shall stand withdrawn forthwith; and
- (v) the said exemption shall be available only during the effectivity of the period under this Order.

Government is pleased to enhance the amount of State Pension to the freedom fighters w.c.f. 1-1-2000 as shown below:

a) Freedom Fighters not drawing Central Pension but drawing State Pension only at the rate of Rs. 1000/- p.m. will now draw Rs. 1,250/- (Rupees one thousand two hundred fifty only).

b) There is no increase in pension for freedom fighters drawing Central pension as well as State Pension since the Central Pension has been doubled. They will continue to draw Rs. 350/- p.m. as at present.

The expenditure in this regard shall be debited to the Budget Head of Account "2235 - Social Security and Welfare Programme, 60 - Other Social Security and Welfare Programme, 102 - Pension under Social Security Scheme, 01 - Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension (Non-Plan), 71 - Pension".
